

Interaction with a Distressed Student

suggested guidelines

If the student is exhibiting behaviors which suggest **he or she might harm him or herself or anyone else, or you feel threatened.**

Call 956-326-2911 or 911 immediately

If the student **needs support** but is **not** exhibiting behaviors that suggest **imminent** self-or other-directed harm, and you **do not** feel threatened.

Call 956-326-2230 & dial #3 to speak with a crisis counselor directly. Do not leave the student alone.

Or

Ask what the student needs and, if they consent, contact, or refer them to the following resources (consult the table below).
