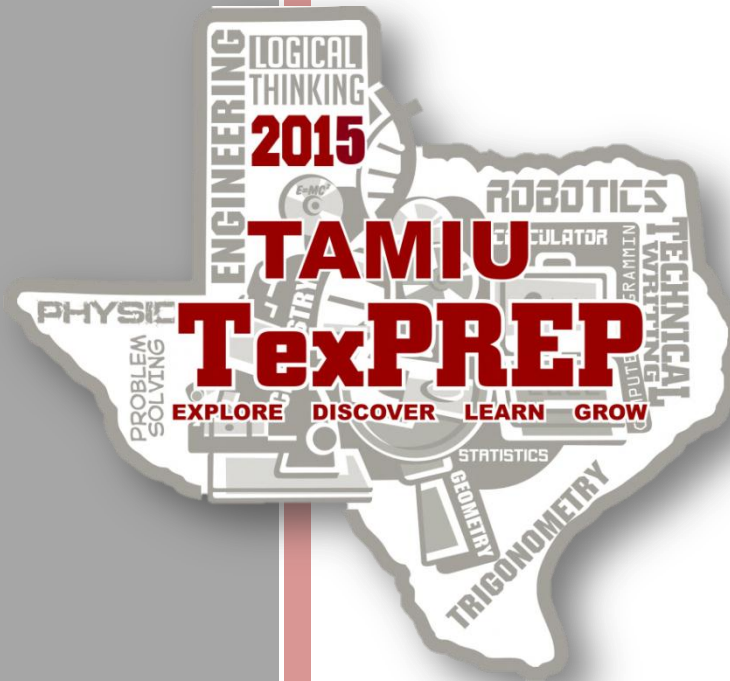

What:

PREP is an 8 week, mathematics-based, academic enrichment program. It emphasizes the development of abstract reasoning and problem solving skills. PREP helps students prepare for careers in the fields of mathematics, science, technology and engineering. The program includes course work, team projects, class presentations, examinations, career awareness speakers, and special events. PREP is presented over the course of four summers. Students reapply each year.

PREP expects to enroll 25 middle school and high school students from Laredo and surrounding counties. Students are eligible if they have successfully completed 3rd year, have an interest and potential for careers in mathematics, technology, science or engineering. Minority students and females are especially encouraged to apply.

Any application after February 12, 2015 will be accepted only if space is available and will have a \$75 application and testing fee.

Any application after March 6, 2015 will be accepted only if space is available and will have a \$100 application and testing fee.

Requirements:

90 average in Math, Science, and English (85 or better if honors or advanced placement)
-Must be in good standing in all courses –A well-written essay-Satisfactory conduct – 9th to 11th grader

Course Requirements- To be completed by June 2015

9th Grade Students: Algebra I

10th Grade Students: At least one of the following: Geometry or Algebra II

11th Grade Students: Must have completed both; Geometry and Algebra II

- I understand that TexPREP is a rigorous and demanding program that requires the ability and motivation to complete complex classwork and homework, above and beyond standard school instruction.
- I understand that my child must attend PREP every weekday from June 08, 2015 to July 30, 2015 (Monday- Thursday). I also understand that he/she will have homework daily and must have or find access to a computer with internet capabilities.
