What:	PREP is an 8 week, mathematics-based, academic enrichment program. It emphasizes the development of abstract reasoning and problem solving skills. PREP helps students prepare for careers in the fields of mathematics, science, technology and engineering. The program includes course work, team projects, class presentations, examinations, career awareness speakers, and special events. PREP is presented over the course of four summers. Students reapply each year.			
Who:	PREP expects to enroll 25 middle school and high school students from Laredo and surrounding counties. Students are eligible if they have successfully completed 3 rd year, have an interest and potential for careers in mathematics, technology, science or engineering. Minority students and females are especially encouraged to apply.
