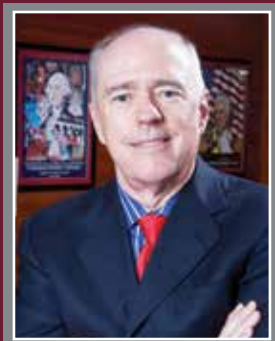

PARKING

During **Discover TAMU**, the University will be a hub of activities with hundreds of guests from all across Texas and northern Mexico. PARKING FOR BUSES

The drop off location for large groups has been designated as the Student Center, accessed from Entrance 3 if traveling from south to north on Loop 20 or Entrance 1 if entering through University Boulevard.

After dropping off students in the designated area, all buses should depart and use the parking lot at the Zaffirini Success Center (University Success Center) located on the south side of campus.

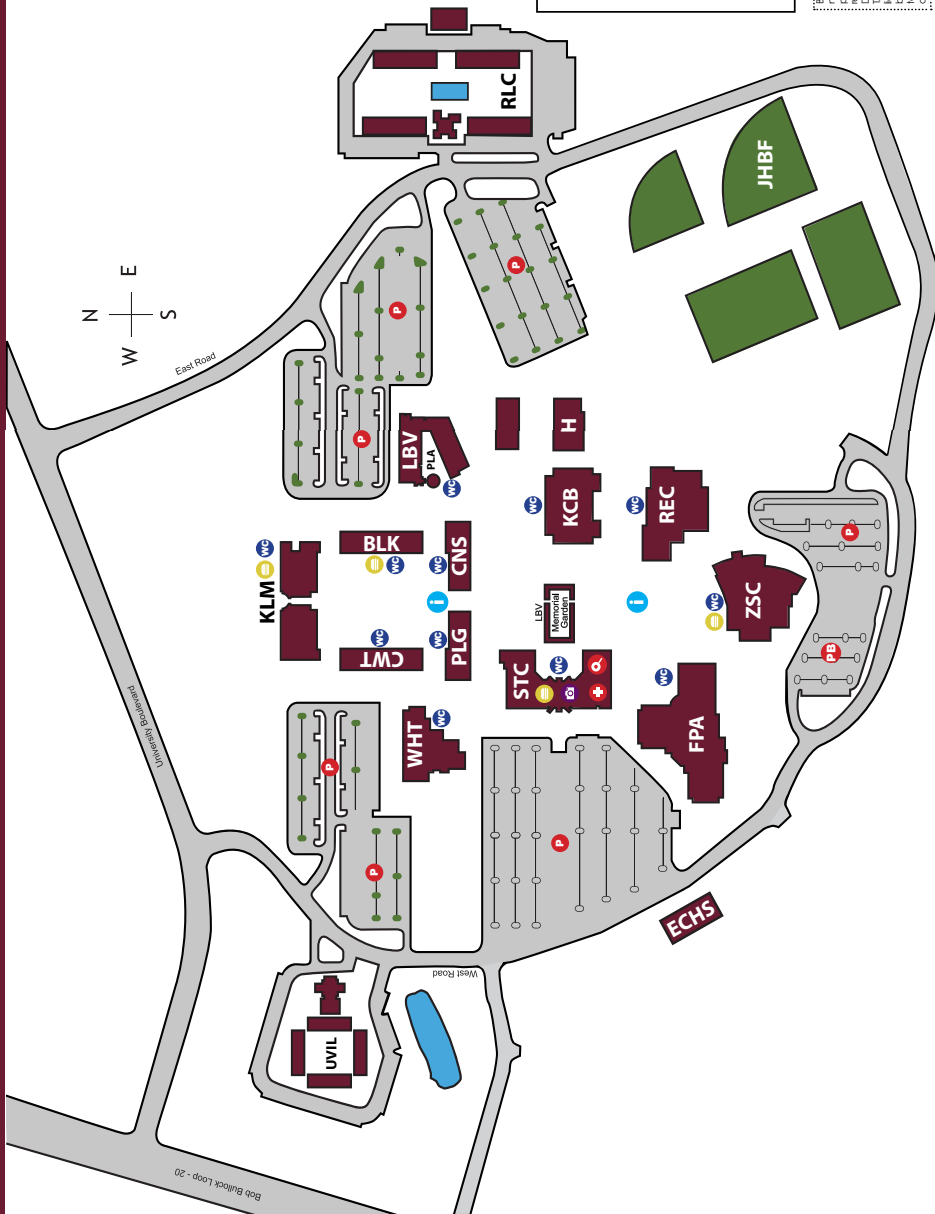
