Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a fully admitted graduate student working towards a master's or doctoral degree.
- Scholarships and Fellowships must enroll in 6 graduate hours each semester (or Summer) while receiving LBV funding.
- Assistantships must be full-time students enrolled in 9 graduate hours each semester (or 6 SCH in Summer) while receiving LBV funding.
- Must maintain a minimum overall GPA of 3.5.

Important Information:

- Complete application and materials are due in the Office of Graduate Studies by April 1 (earlier is preferred).
- Award announcement letters are issued in early June.

Instructions:

Please print or type application in black ink. To be eligible, a student must meet all of the requirements as specified above. For priority consideration, please submit the completed application form to the Texas A&M International University Office of Graduate Studies on or before the deadline. Applications received after this date will be reviewed on a first-come basis as funds permit. Priority shall be given to students from Laredo and surrounding areas.

All necessary materials (i.e., application, resume, essay, letters of recommendation, and unofficial transcripts) must be postmarked or received on or before the deadline. Applicants are strongly encouraged to submit all necessary documents as soon as possible to assure that a last-minute delay will not preclude consideration for an award.

Personal Statement (Essay)

Please attach a typed (double-spaced) essay of approximately 300 words that briefly describes your career goals and aspirations. For the Assistantship and Fellowship award, the essay should describe the duties you expect to perform.

Letters of Recommendation

Please attach 2-3 letters of recommendation that address your past academic and/or professional accomplishments. These letters should also address your future academic goals.

Resume

- Educational background.
- Work Experience include employment responsibilities, number of hours per week and time of employment.
- Extracurricular activities include organizations and officer positions held.
- Community / volunteer activities Include years of participation and leadership positions held.
- Academic honors.

Graduate Assistantships are stipends up to \$18,000 per year (20 hours of work per week). Graduate Fellowships are stipends up to \$6,000 per year (10 hours of work per week). Graduate Scholarships up to \$3,000 per year.
