Eligibility Requirements:

- Must enroll in 6 or more graduate hours each semester at TAMIU (including summer) to receive scholarship money.
- Must maintain a minimum overall GPA of 3.5.
- Application deadline is May 1 (earlier is preferred).

Students will be offered a one-time \$500 scholarship for graduate study at TAMIU. This will be increased to \$1000 per term once fully admitted into a graduate program at TAMIU.

Instructions:

Please print or type application in black ink. To be eligible, a student must meet all of the requirements as specified by the scholarship. For priority consideration, please submit completed application form to the Texas A&M International University Office of Graduate Studies & Research on or before the deadline. Applications received after this date will be reviewed on a first-come basis as funds permit. Priority shall be given to students from Laredo and surrounding areas.

All necessary materials (i.e., scholarship application, essay, letters of recommendation, and unofficial transcripts) must be postmarked or received on or before the deadline. Applicants are strongly encouraged to submit all necessary documents as soon as possible to assure that a last-minute delay will not preclude consideration for a scholarship.

Personal Statement (Essay)

Please attach a typed (double-spaced) essay of approximately 500 words written entirely on your own. This essay should describe your interests, your accomplishment, and your future plans or goals.

Letters of Recommendation

Please attach 2-3 letters of recommendation that address your past academic and/or professional accomplishments. These letters should also address your future academic goals.
