POSITION TITLE: Assistant Professor of Public Administration

DUTIES: The Department of Social Sciences at Texas A&M International University (TAMIU) seeks an Assistant Professor of Public Administration (tenure-track, 9-month position) to begin Fall 2023. Duties include teaching undergraduate and graduate courses in Public Administration and Political Science, publishing research in Public Administration and/or closely related areas, advising MPA students, participating in MPA program governance, and serving on departmental, college, and university committees. Tenure-track faculty receive a reduced teaching load (2-2 for the first two years, 2-3/3-2 for the third year, and 3-3 thereafter).

REQUIREMENTS: The successful candidate must hold an earned doctorate in Public Administration or a closely related field. ABDs may be considered but they must have earned a doctoral degree before appointment. We are interested in candidates with substantial experience in teaching, research, and grant acquisition in the area of public and nonprofit management. The successful candidate will also be able to deliver courses in research methods. We desire candidates with strong research skills, a strong record of or potential for sustained publication in peerreviewed journals, the potential for or prior experience with seeking and/or securing external grant funding, experience working with diverse student populations, and the ability to teach MPA core courses and in areas that complement or strengthen our graduate and undergraduate programs.
