



Click on "Register" to create username




Step 1 - Select Texas A & M International University from the drop-down menu




Step 2 - Enter your name & email address

Step 5 - Continuing Education Unit (CEU) credit and surveys


Most principal investigators should select "**no**". Some fields of study such as nursing and psychology require annual CEU credits to maintain certifications and this course can partially satisfy requirements. Select an answer to the research survey question.

If you answer "yes", you will be provided with information before you start a CEU-eligible course about the amount of credit available, information about the course authors, and other required CEU disclosures. This information must be viewed before a course is started in order for you to be eligible to purchase CEU credit after course completion. 
Step 6 – Fill in information with asterisks next to it.



Step 8 – Beginning the course

Click on the course name to complete the courses (you can complete course in multiple sessions - it doesn't have to be all at once). IRB training is good for 1 year, IACUC training is good for 2 years, and Responsible Conduct of Research Training is good for 4 years. The CITI program will email you a reminder when you are due to take refresher training.
