Concurrent Enrollment Guidelines

At Texas A&M International University qualified high school students may enroll in university-level courses as a concurrent enrollment student. The following guidelines outline the process for students interested in participating in the Concurrent Enrollment Program and advancing their college education at Texas A&M International University.

Concurrent Enrollment Program Requirements

Student must be a current high school student enrolled in a program of study.

A new **student** who is seeking admissions for the first time to the concurrent enrollment program will need to:

- 1. Submit an ApplyTexas Application (www.goapplytexas.org)
- 2. Submit official High School Transcript (sealed envelope or Parchment)
- 3. Have a minimum High School GPA of 85 or 3.0
- 4. Have attempted all sections of the TSI placement exam
- 5. Submit proof of the Bacterial Meningitis Vaccine
- 6. Submit the Concurrent Authorization and Acknowledgement Statement form with necessary signatures

The students <u>Parent/Guardian</u> will need to sign and acknowledge the Concurrent Authorization and Acknowledgement Statement form.

High school freshmen and sophomore students must undergo a secondary admissions review process by the Concurrent Admissions Committee.

Concurrent Admission to TAMIU is only granted for the semester for which students apply. Students who do not enroll for the semester for which they are approved should contact the Office of Recruitment and School Relations before attempting to enroll for another semester.

Returning Concurrent Enrollment Students

A **<u>student</u>** who will be continuing the Concurrent Enrollment Program will need to:

- 1. Submit an updated official High School Transcript (sealed envelope or Parchment)
- 2. Have a minimum High School GPA of 85 or 3.0
- 3. Have and maintain a TAMIU GPA of 2.0 or higher
- 4. Submit the Concurrent Authorization and Acknowledgement Statement form with necessary signatures
