## ✓ OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT

An official high school transcript must be submitted for admission consideration. To be considered official, a transcript must have original signature of a school official or an original school seal.

- Official transcripts may be submitted electronically.
- Transcripts should include graduation plan, courses, class rank and size, and most recent GPA  
*If your school does not use class rankings, please include student's most recent GPA. The Office of Undergraduate Admissions will assign a percentage ranking for your student.*

## ✓ OFFICIAL SAT AND/OR ACT SCORES

SAT or ACT scores must be sent from the official testing agency. TAMU combines test scores from different test dates to get the highest possible scores (i.e., superscore). SAT and ACT scores are used to determine a student's qualification for TAMU's Merit-Based Freshman Scholarships.

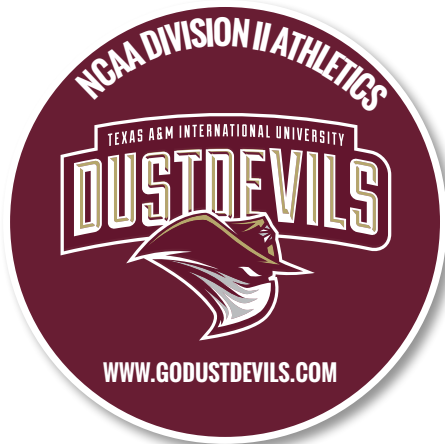

## Counselors



### SCHOLARSHIPS

The priority deadline for TAMU's Merit-Based Freshman Scholarships is Dec. 1. Please encourage students to submit and complete their admission process by date to guarantee scholarship funds.



### ONLINE TOOLS

Encourage students to check their admissions application status online at [myapp.tamui.edu](http://myapp.tamui.edu).



### DUAL CREDIT COURSES

Your students may potentially earn credit for the college courses they took while in high school. Encourage your students to submit their official college transcript(s) to TAMU.



### SCHOOL EMAILS

Inform students to use their personal email on all applications and forms. Encourage them to avoid using their school email as these typically expire upon graduation.



### TSI

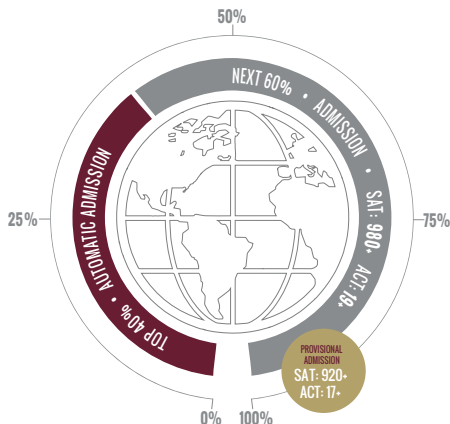
It's never too early to encourage taking the TSI Placement Exam. Advocate for students to take the TSI Placement Exam to ensure college readiness. Some exemptions may apply.



### AP EXAMS

Depending on the AP exam and the score your student earns on these exams, they may be eligible to earn credit for college courses. Recommend your students send us their official AP scores as soon as they become available.
