# **University Update: Dr. Arenaz**

Regent Bellinger was on campus last week; the visit went well. When students met with him, they brought up a couple of issues. One issue is wifi connectivity; we are continuously working to update our technology. The students also had some complaints about faculty being unapproachable. Dr. Arenaz reminded them to be honest on their student evaluations.

VPs had a robust discussion about transfers at the last meeting. If we are going to grow, we need to make a concerted effort to increase number of transfer students. We have some new initiatives starting in Enrollment Management. We need to make sure we help transfers make the transition.

We need to move forward with certifications and incorporating them into our degree programs. These certificates will address marketable skills.
