Assignment Tasks

Assignment	Time Needed	Outcome
Weekly Quizzes	 Read Chapters for the Assigned Module and take helpful notes. (~ 40 mins to 1 hr.) Recommended: Read one section from the chapter daily prior to the quiz. Watch Instructor's lecture videos for each Module and take helpful notes. (~ 30 mins to 1.5 hr.) Review notes taken and key terms/points. Take the Quiz online through Respondus Lockdown Browser expect multiple choice and essay questions. (Timed = 1 hour) Review feedback from instructor and prepare for the following module. 	You will be ready to take the weekly quiz and gather important notes that might be needed for the midterm/final exam. The lecture videos posted by the professor provide the necessary content to answer the questions on the quizzes.
Final Exam	Begin studying for the final at least three weeks in advance!!! To study: Re-read Chapters and notes taken for the previous quizzes. (~1.5 – 2 hours) Re-watch lecture videos for the modules you may need to revisit. (~2 hrs. depending on the module) Taken online through Respondus Lockdown Browser. You have 3 hours to complete it. This exam has multiple choice questions along with some essay questions and problems. Essay questions will be checked for plagiarism on Turnitin.	If you plan to study in a timely manner, you will be ready to take your final exam <i>mostly</i> stress-free. By re-watching the lecture videos, you may find concepts and possible answers that may come out on the exam that the professor has previously mentioned. If you try to answer possible essay questions ahead of time, you will be ready to submit them on the final exam.



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Research Project:

Students will work on a research project in groups of one or two and will submit a written report of 4 pages for a single person and 5-6 pages for a group of two. Project is divided into four tasks and various due dates:

- Topic Selection: (30 40 mins)
 - Decide if you wish to work individually or with a partner.
 - Select a topic for your research paper.
 - Submit in the drop box a brief summary of your selected Research Paper Topic and Name of Authors.
- Find Credible Sources: (1 hour)
 - Watch videos on finding credible sources provided by professor.
 - Research credible sources to use on your paper.
 - Participate in the designated Discussion Forum.
- Reference List: (40 mins 1 hour)
 - Complete Research Paper Reference Assignment.
- Final Research Paper: (< 2 weeks)
 Plan accordingly!
 - Review the Grading Rubric and guidelines for the research paper.
 - Check for grammar and plagiarism. (Sign up for Grammarly Premium).
 - Submit your written report that clearly describes the topic.

The research paper assignment is worth a high percentage of your total grade. Therefore, having a well-written essay and submitting it on time will increase your overall grade.

The project consists of four different steps that you must submit in order to help your grade. Not submitting them will lower your grade.
